**I will follow the rules of the house (or wherever else I may be) and I will do what is expected of me each day. I will avoid non-compliant behaviors such as arguing, begging, complaining, or whining.**

**I will be patient, honest, fair, and courteous with others.**

**I will present a positive attitude instead of being negative, pessimistic, or rude.**

**As long as I maintain the expectations listed in this agreement, I may continue to be an active participant of *iL.E.A.D. Success Tutoring and Mentoring*.**

**If I am unable to meet the expectations listed in this agreement, I will be restricted from participating in *iL.E.A.D. Success Tutoring and Mentoring* for present and future endeavors.**

## Behavioral Contract

### Consequences for Failure to Comply

iL.E.A.D. Success Tutoring & Mentoring will keep file of signed behavior contracts for each student. The contract must be signed and dated each Fall/Spring by the student. The following outlines the order of consequences should a student fail to comply with the contract terms. All incidents of failure will be documented and kept on file.

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Violation

**A written warning** will be issued by the supervising staff, including details of the transgression, why it is not acceptable, and how the student should resolve the issue. A notation will be made in the student's file and the parents/guardian will be notified.

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Violation

**A written warning** will be issued by the supervising staff, **and the student will not be allowed to participate in the next field trip.** A detailed notation will be made in the student's file and the parents/guardian will be notified.

#### 3<sup>rd</sup> Violation

**A written warning** will be issued by the supervising staff, **and the student will not be allowed to return to the program for the remainder of the Fall/Spring sessions.** Should the 3<sup>rd</sup> incident occur within the last three program session, then the student will be not be allowed to return to the program for the remainder of the current term and the following Fall/Spring term. A detailed notation will be made in the student's file and the parents/guardian will be notified.
